Individual BOE reports

Chester – Board Chair David Fitzgibbons reported that the Chester BOE met with the Chester BOF and BOS to present the proposed elementary budget. He said that the boards seem committed to working with the BOE to provide the kind of educational experience that they all want to give the students.

Region 4 – Board Vice-Chair Jane Cavanaugh reported that the Region 4 BOE also presented their proposed budget to the town. Vice-Chair Cavanaugh agreed with Deep River Chair Grow that the biggest problem this year is that nobody knows what is going to happen at the State funding level.
