Update on Status of School Reopening – Administrative Team

Superintendent White stated that the purpose of tonight's meeting will be to provide an update to the Chester BOE and community about reopening preparations specifically at Chester Elementary. He reminded everyone about past detailed presentations to the Joint BOE and all communities at Joint BOE meetings held during the last two weeks, videos of which along with copies of the presentation are available on the district website. Additionally, other information has also been posted on the website along with an FAQ representing 50+ questions received from the public. Joining the meeting this evening are Principal Stoddard and CES Facilities Manager James Grzybowski to also provide insight on CES specific questions.
