These changes are due to a known change in personnel that has occurred resulting in a cost savings due to a lower salary and benefits budget requirement; as well as some requests made by the Board of Finance/Board of Selectpersons which do not show up in the district's budget total, but do reduce the capital request for inclusion in the town's overall budget. The salary change is seen in the Supervision District lines, as that position is a direct bill to Chester by the Supervision District.

The Board is scheduled to vote on their proposed budget at their March 25th regular meeting. The Board requested no further changes to the proposed budget but did ask Administration to provide them with a little more information with regards to the proposed request to fund a building study at their next meeting, prior to their vote on the budget.

Mr. White gave a brief report. Spring Sports are being held. Things have been better in the district managing Covid. Teachers are being vaccinated. End of year ceremonies are being reviewed.

Current Year to Date Financial Status Update

Mr. Grissom gave an update on the financial reports. CES is trending well at this time. It appears that all expenses will be covered for the remainder of the year. Mr. Grissom will keep the Board apprised of any changes that may occur.

Cafeteria Fund Update

Mr. Grissom gave a brief update on the cafeteria reporting. This is trending well. The cafeteria is able to cover all of its expenses.

Medical Reserve Tracking

Favorable results in the Medical Reserve account. Claim activity is expected to return to prior levels.

Principal's Update

Mr. Stoddard gave a brief update. Kindergarten orientation took place. At this time we number of new students is approximately 34. Mr. Stoddard gave an update on the outdoor classroom. The Rotary helped procure additional salt water fish for the aquarium. A digital camera will be used to allow students to monitor the fish when they are away from school. The Invention Convention took place. The state level will be held virtually. The morning broadcast included both students in school and students learning virtually. The food collection for the food pantry is complete. A podcast by students will be enjoyed by classrooms.
